The SCAD installation utilizes lighting, fans and sheets of very thin plastic to fill the space with watery, rippling forms. The art will be best viewed through the huge windows at the front of the building. A lighting scheme in shades of blue transforms the space into an ocean, while the plastic forms that the students build onsite will inflate with air to become "waves" that ripple throughout the space.

THE FLOOR & installation will also be best viewed from the outside at the vantage point of the building. He's using a combination of latex and spray paint to "pattern" the interior sheet rock walls as well as parts of the windows. Interior lighting will be pointed in the direction of the work on the windows and walls to create a "glowing" effect.

The film "Sideways" kicks off Castleberry Point's Movie Night, a monthly movie night in the courtyard of the mixed use condos situated in the heart of Castleberry Hill. The film follows two men who are reaching middle age with not much to show but disappointment. They embark on a week-long road trip through California's wine country, just as one is about to take a trip down the aisle. The Wine Shoe will host a merlot tasting in the spirit of the character Miles's aversion to merlot.
